

Callide A Power Station – Visitor Instructions

CS Energy's Callide A Power Station is the site of the Callide Oxyfuel Project, a low emission demonstration project.

All visitors to Callide A are by appointment only.

Process for visitors

1. Before arriving at Callide A, all visitors must go to the neighbouring Callide B power station complex to obtain your swipe card. The turnoff to Callide B is located approximately 1km before Callide A as you travel from Biloela.
2. On arrival at Callide B, please advise the security guard that you are visiting Callide A and you will be given the Visitor Induction (10 minutes) and issued with a visitor swipe card. The visitor induction is not required if you are immediately attending the Grade 2 Induction at Callide A.
3. Proceed to the Callide A Power Station carpark, swipe your visitor card to enter the station via the turnstile and report to reception (follow signs).
4. At the end of your visit, please return your swipe card to Callide A Reception. If you did a Grade 2 induction, hold onto your visitor card until you are issued with your permanent access card (3-4days).

Dress requirements

Please wear your own enclosed foot wear, cotton trousers and long-sleeved cotton shirt. A safety helmet, safety glasses, hearing protection and high visibility workwear/vests must also be worn and are available from Callide A if you do not have them.

Inductions required

1. Callide Grade 1 – 10 minute video for occasional or short term visitors who are being accompanied around site by a person with a Callide A Grade 2 induction. You will not be able to sign on to a Permit to Work (PTW) with this induction. Induction is valid for 24 months.
2. Callide A Grade 2 – Two hour induction required for all personnel working on site (except occasional or short term visitors). Induction carried out at Callide A on Monday and Wednesday mornings at 7.15am (book five days earlier). This induction must be carried out prior to working onsite and covers the Construction Safety Plan, site conditions, Environmental Management Plan requirements and community relations. Valid for 24 months.

All Grade 2 inductees must also show they hold a White Card (Unit of competency – CPCCOHS1001A 'Work safely in the construction industry') or a Queensland Construction Blue Card or equivalent. Note: As parts of Callide A are deemed a construction site until August 2011, Callide B and C inductions are not sufficient to work on site.
