Capacity: 750 MW

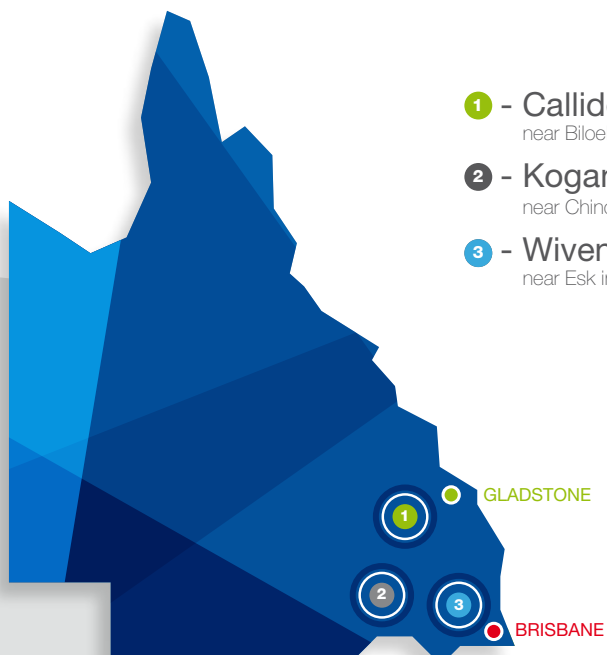
Fuel: Black coal from the CS Energy-owned Kogan Mine
