Early this morning a group of Greenpeace activists accessed Swanbank Power Station at Ipswich in South East Queensland.

A CS Energy spokesperson said that emergency services personnel are on site and in control of the situation.

All site staff are safe.

As a precaution, generation from the Swanbank B Power Station has been held stable at overnight levels.

Swanbank Power Station comprises the 480 megawatt, coal-fired B station and the high efficiency 385 megawatt gas-fired E station.

CS Energy owns and operates four power stations around Queensland and supplies approximately one third of the State's electricity demand.
