Help us manage our risks

We know that there are certain groups of people who are at higher risk for COVID-19.

Federal Government noted on 29 March this includes:

- People aged over 70
- People aged over 65 with pre-existing conditions
- Indigenous people aged over 50 with pre-existing conditions.

We're focused on helping you stay as fit and healthy as possible through this pandemic. To help us do this, our Health and Safety and People and Culture teams are working to better understand the individuals within the higher risk groups and put specific risk controls in place to keep you safe.

As a reminder, please tell your supervisor if you, or someone you're living with, needs to selfisolate or are being tested for COVID-19.

Again, our process is to work with the Health and Safety team to put the right risk controls in place.



Ongoing border restrictions

You would have noticed last week that Queensland implemented border controls, which were updated last night with respect to FIFO workers.

These border controls are in place to inhibit the movement of COVID-19, but not to inhibit the critical service provided by CS Energy.
