### **PFAS update - year in review**

Hello,

The CS Energy team wishes you a safe and happy festive season.

As 2025 comes to a close we'd like to say thank you for working with us this year and give you an update on what our plans are for the coming months.

### **Ongoing landholder property monitoring - commencing in January**

We completed annual sampling of landholder properties in March this year.

This was the fifth round of sampling offered to all landholders, with the results indicating PFAS levels at the majority of locations were reducing overall. There are some areas that show an increasing trend, however current results do not exceed any historical levels.

**The next round of landholder sampling will start from 12 January 2026. Epic Environmental will begin calls to schedule sampling from 5 January 2026.**

### **Ongoing technical monitoring**

The technical monitoring program continued with sampling conducted in March, July and October with 16 rounds now completed.

The next round will begin in February 2026.

## **Community drop-in session**

We are looking at holding our next community drop-in session around February next year. Once we have a date, venue and invited attendees confirmed we will be in touch with the details.

## **Working with DETSI under an Environmental Enforcement Order (EEO)**

This year our main focus was to continue to work with DETSI to complete the required actions within the timeframes on the EEO.

The key action was to submit a draft Remediation Action Plan on 3 December. This report is now with DETSI for consideration and includes detail on:

- PFAS water treatment trial completed onsite at Callide Power Station – the trial was to understand specific foam fractionation technology to remove PFAS in surface water and groundwater onsite for potential future remediation.
- Evaluations of the findings to-date of the water filtration systems being trialled on landholder properties.
- Seepage recovery management with focus on upgrading the current seepage recovery network.
- Other remediation and management strategies and timing considerations.

## **Our water support arrangements**

Our support continues to be guided by advice from government health agencies and based on individual household domestic water requirements.

Our support is intended to provide alternative supply to landholders relying on bore water for domestic purposes. It isn't to guarantee water security for your property or replace your bore supply if it becomes inadequate for domestic or other uses.

CS Energy provides water support with community health as the top priority, while ensuring equity, sustainability, and protection of the town's water supply both now and into the future.

CS Energy understands that water is a precious resource and encourages those receiving water support through bottled or potable water deliveries to be water wise. Small actions like shorter showers and turning taps off quickly can make a big difference.

A reminder for those receiving potable water deliveries to check your existing supply in your tanks before your delivery is expected.
