CS Energy's Brigalow Peaking Power Plant

The Brigalow Peaking Power Plant is a 400 MW gas-fired peaking plant to be located on CS Energy land to the east of Kogan Creek Power Station.

The project team is mobilising to site this week to conduct early works in preparation for construction to commence in 2026.

Early works include:

- upgrading and widening the intersection from Banana Bridge Road to the Kogan Creek Power Station to enable the safe delivery of the gas turbines
- construction of a separate site access road to run alongside the existing Kogan Creek Power Station access road
- civil surveys, flora/fauna surveys, erosion and sediment controls, weed spraying, clearing culverts and table drains
- establishment of temporary site offices

The first visible activity will be the installation of the VMS information boards on Banana Bridge Road, adjacent to Frees Road and Smiths Road intersections, on **28 November**.

Speed restrictions along Banana Bridge Road

Speed limits of 40 km/h to 60 km/h will be in place along Banana Bridge Road (near the Kogan Creek Power Station intersection) from 1 December 2025 to enable the safe execution of early works.

Work will pause over Christmas from **20 December to 4 January**. During this time, the speed limits will revert to regular limits.
